As part of its skills development initiatives, **Transport Education Training Authority** awards bursaries annually for studies aligned to critical and scarce skills identified in the transport sector skills plan. Bursary awards are categorised according to sector requirements, with due consideration of the National Skills Development Plan - 2030, compiled by the Department of Higher Education and Training. Transport Education Training Authority (TETA) is offering bursaries and invites qualifying unemployed learners to apply for bursaries or funding for the 2022 academic year.

Learners eligible for bursaries: • Currently in Grade 12 or have completed matric intending to study any of the qualifications listed below in 2022 • Currently registered students at Institutions of Higher Learning (including TVET colleges) and require funding for the 2022 academic year • Aviation students with valid PPL/CPL • Commercial Divers with matric (Senior Certificate). Applications must be to accredited aviation schools, accredited diving schools and registered TVETs and HEIs. **Only online applications will be accepted. NOTE: Manual or email applications will not be considered.**
